In January, three Lithuanian medical professionals also worked in Ukraine. A dentist and nurse team provided dental care to civilians remaining in de-occupied territories and to soldiers who were unable to leave their positions. An anaesthesiologist carried out medical evacuations of wounded soldiers between frontline treatment facilities.
