In March, a Lithuanian volunteer orthopaedic trauma surgeon worked at a military hospital in Ukraine, performing 18 operations. At the evacuation base, an anaesthesiologist worked to transfer critically wounded soldiers from a stabilisation point to a higher-level medical facility.
